

Alessandro Moretti is the Federal Police Chief (Special Class), he holds a Bachelor of Law degree from Riopretense University in São Paulo. He is a Specialist in Public Security Management by the National Police Academy and he is also Specialist in State Intelligence and Public Security Intelligence by the Public Ministry University in Minas Gerais State.

Mr. Moretti is a National Police Academy Teacher. He joined the Federal Police in 1999 in the Tax Crimes Prevention and Repression Station in charge of the Regional Federal Police in São Paulo State.

He was the Head of the Federal Police Station of Araraquara in São Paulo State, from 2005 to 2007. He was also the Regional Chief to fight organized crime in charge of the Regional Federal Police of Minas Gerais State, from November 2007 to February 2009.

Since February 2009, he has been the General Coordinator of CINTEPOL - Integrated Police Intelligence Center and Strategic Analysis of the Federal Police Intelligence.

Mr. Moretti was the coordinator, supervisor and performer of several Police Operations to fight organized crime, among them:

Gladiator Operation Coordinator - combating the so called "slots machines" mafia, which explores many illicit activities, in particular, the illegal gambling in Rio de Janeiro State. When the operation was concluded, many polices, political agents, public servers and organized crime leaders were arrested and sentenced, many of their goods and thousands of "slots machines" were seized and dozens of game's house were closed.

Chapel Operation Coordinator - combating money laundering, cross-border and tax evasion, smuggling and piracy, for the one that was considered the biggest smuggler. In this operation were made the largest seizures of smuggled and piracy products in Brazil, in addition to the largest seizure of virgin media in the world, produced without respect to the patents and that would be used for piracy market supply.

Themis Operation Coordinator – combating the public servers corruption – judges, police and tax auditors – which provided the businessmen to obtain decisions that facilitated the conceal of hundreds millions in Federal and State Taxes. This operation also found corruption to obtain judicial decisions authorizing the operation of gambling houses (bingos) and closed dozens of houses that was operating in São Paulo State.

In 2008, Mr. Moretti was the Supervisor of around 50 Police Operations in Minas Gerais State, to fight organized crime – money laundering, financial crimes, narcotics trafficking, cargo theft, embezzlement of public funds, etc – highlighting "João de Barro Operation" (procurement fraud that would result in losses of more than 2 billion in the public coffers) and "Pasargadae Operation" (investigation of more than 100 municipalities of Minas Gerais and other States, with the arrest of some mayors for the practice of various crimes, especially procurement fraud and embezzlement of public funds).
