Lt-Col. László Tarr has been appointed as the Director of Hungarian National Police Headquarters International Law Enforcement Cooperation Centre (ILECC) in 2009.

Prior to this position, from 1st of August 2005 till 1st of September 2009, Lt-Col. László Tarr worked as the Head of the Schengen Cooperation (SIRENE) Unit operating at ILECC and was responsible for planning and coordinating the establishment and full operation of this newly integrated section of the police with regards to organisation, IT, legal, training, personnel and operational aspects. As project leader, Mr. Tarr supervised and directed the implementation of the national development projects related to the use of Schengen Information System in the period of Hungary's preparation for the access to the Schengen Area and afterwards.

From July 2001 till November 2002 Mr. Tarr served as the Deputy Chief of Regional Training Unit in Doboj, Bosnia Herzegovina in the frame of a United Nations peacekeeping mission. His daily work was to coordinate, plan and control the implementation of different training programs, as well as to evaluate the local police training activities.

Between 1997 and 2005 Lt-Col. László Tarr worked as a chief inspector and duty officer at ILECC, at Interpol National Unit Duty Service Subdivision at first and at SIRENE Project Bureau afterwards, where he was responsible for overseeing and coordinating the "Schengen-related" police tasks and duties on national level among others.

He graduated in 2001 at University of West Hungary and in 1997 at Hungarian Police Academy.
